## Who are Box Power CIC?

Box Power CIC are a not-for-profit energy consultancy, founded in 2014 by Corin and Tricia Dalby.

It is the UK's first philanthropic not-for-profit energy consultancy for business, with all profits donated to local and regional charities.

As well as donating over £800,000 to charities, and brokering cost effective energy deals for their clients, Box Power CIC is campaigning for greater transparency in the energy buying industry.

# What is the Box Power CIC Performance Table?

Box Power CIC sent a freedom of information request to each UK council and other public bodies to find out the energy usage and spending of each from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.

Box Power CIC is striving to bring more transparency into the energy sector and has compiled the Box Power CIC Performance Table for the second year in a row, detailing how much public bodies have been spending on their gas and electricity.

Last year, the findings featured in The Times, Mail Online, The Yorkshire Post, Manchester Evening News, The MJ and more.

This year, there are once again huge differentials in the prices being paid.

# How do local authorities buy energy?

The way local authorities and public sector bodies buy energy differs from how households, and even businesses, buy energy.

Local authorities bulk buy energy in advance and have hedging policies in place to ensure they get a good deal.

But they have to either seek a full formal open tender process and buy independently, or they could join an existing framework agreement.

These are mostly run by Public Buying Organisations, of which the largest is the Crown Commercial Service, while other councils form their own buying group - usually in regional clusters.

## How to analyse the figures

When setting out the Box Power CIC Performance Table, to adjust for any differences in sizes between councils, Box Power translated usage and spend to the price per kWh.

Therefore, looking at the p/p/kwh column for both gas and electric is a fair indication of which councils have bought at higher prices. Of course, some authorities are bigger than others - but what matters is the price they pay per unit that way we can compare them fairly. Some are paying **far** more than others.

In their rankings, the public bodies that spent the most per kwh of electricity and gas are ranked closest to 1, and the public bodies that spent the least per kwh on electricity and gas are ranked closest to 400. The ranking of each public body also enables you to calculate the average ranking in each region, to find out on average which ones performed better.

For councils with similar energy usages, there is also a table to make direct comparisons between different councils that have some of the largest discrepancies in p/p/kwh they paid for gas and electricity.

## Headline figures

**£700,000,000** is the cost **local authorities** could have saved had they bought at the same rate as national Government departments during the period.

Local authorities have paid **63%** more on average than what they could have paid if they bought at the same rate as national government.

Emergency services could have saved **£63,000,000** had they bought at the same rate as national government.

Central government has saved **£1,200,000,000** by not paying for energy at the same pence per kwh average price as local authorities during the period.
